- 1. Optimizing Child Development: Nature offers a dynamic platform for preschool and primary school children to undergo comprehensive cognitive, social-emotional, physical, and language development.
- 2. Environmental Awareness: The project emphasizes the significance of instilling environmental awareness in children during their formative years.
- 3. Holistic Learning: Children's learning skills and attention span are enriched through engaging with nature, resulting in enhanced cognitive abilities and improved focus.
- 4. Cultural Exchange and Skill Diversification: Collaboration among individuals from diverse cultures and backgrounds is promoted, fostering valuable educational interactions.
- 5. Natural Learning Environment: Learning within a natural setting accelerates skill acquisition, boosts retention, and nurtures essential life skills such as organization, teamwork, and responsibility.
- 6. Creative Exploration: Green spaces encourage creative play and cooperative interactions, leading to increased cognitive capacities and social development.
- 7. Attention and Academic Success: Research indicates that exposure to nature reduces attention deficit symptoms and enhances academic achievements in children.
- 8. Physical Activity and Nutrition: Time spent in various natural environments correlates with higher physical activity levels, improved nutritional awareness, and stronger interpersonal connections.
- 9. Self-Control and Stress Reduction: Children immersed in green areas exhibit improved self-control, decreased stress, and lower anxiety
- 10. International Collaboration: The project is orchestrated by the Matthias Bildungs Institute in Frankfurt, Germany, in partnership with Portugal, Turkey, and Romania. The initiative fosters cross-country educational and training activities, involving three educators from each participating country.
